Builder Mike Smith Construction. **Joinery** Custom joinery by Noe Erazo of High Quality Custom Cabinetry in rift-cut white oak veneer with custom stain and honed Caprice White stone. **Benchtop/splashback** Honed Caprice White stone. **Wall/ceiling finish** Waxed plaster in custom colour to match Benjamin Moore 'White Dove'. **Flooring** Existing timber floor sanded and re-stained in custom colour. **Sink** Two Clayburn 'Fireclay Farmhouse Apron' sinks from Waterworks. **Tapware** Cocoon 'Mono 12' with pull-out spray; Quooker 'Fusion' round tap; in pantry, 'Natura 2' tap dispensing tower with remote chiller by Natura Water. **Appliances** Wolf 60" 'Dual Fuel' oven and 'Pro' wall hood. INFUSED WITH A CALIFORNIAN openness, the Bay Blue house comes together as a layering of curated elements, according to Justine Hugh-Jones and Katrina Mackintosh of Hugh-Jones Mackintosh who combined natural tones with a limited palette of finishes in the kitchen. Fusing influences from east-coast Australia and west-coast US the result sees an inviting open dialogue, say the designers. "By engaging a non-local design team, the owners sought to ensure a sense of restraint was used, deviating from a heavier, more traditional American response but still representing who they are." *What luxury items did you choose for this kitchen regardless of budget?* "Decorative, sculptural lighting is always a luxury item in a kitchen; it is a key element to soften what otherwise can be a purely functional space.
